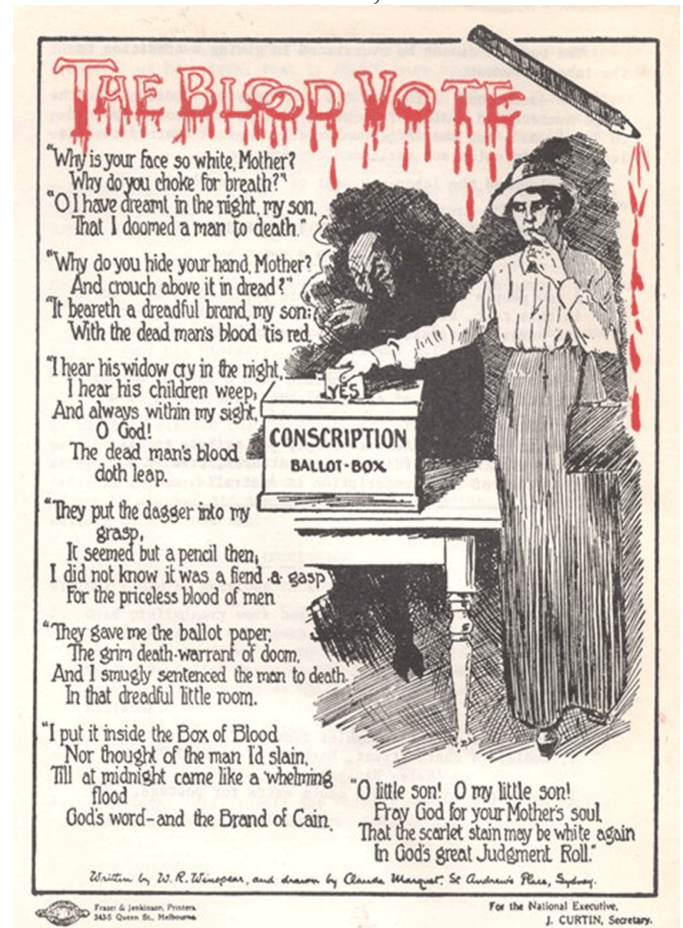


H.3: The Great War, Australia at war : Australia's response to the outbreak of war: enlistment for the war.
