

École maternelle = PRESCHOOL (petite et moy. section) + KINDERGARDEN (gde section)
École primaire = PRIMARY SCHOOL
Collège = SECONDARY SCHOOL ou HIGH SCHOOL
Lycée = SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL ou COLLEGE

What is Australia territory?

- 7.69 million square kilometres
- Pacific and the Indian Ocean
- 3700 kilometres from north to south and 4000 kilometres from east to west
- Sixth-largest nation in the world.
- More than 80 per cent of residents live within 100 kilometres of the coastline
- 23 million people
- Less than 600 millimetres of rain per year
