❖ Description :

To do this, you must choose a news item (cyclone, earthquake, tsunami, pandemic, etc.) (*for this work, the current event must have taken place within the last ten years max*) based on reliable sources, and specify them in your work; then you have to go back to the main ideas that make this a natural disaster.

- 2) CIA Fact Box – *country Need To Know*
