Born and raised in Los Angeles, Billie Eilish was barely a teenager when her song "Ocean Eyes" became a viral hit. She teamed with her brother, Finneas O'Connell, to create the tracks for the breakout EP *Don't Smile at Me* and the smash album *When We All Fall Asleep, Where Do We Go*?, establishing the artist as a global sensation and seven-time Grammy winner before the age of 20. To date, she has won nine Grammy Awards and is known for the songs "Bad Guy," "Everything I Wanted," and "What Was I Made For?" from the *Barbie* movie

soundtrack.

Early Life and Family

Billie Eilish was born on December 18, 2001, in Los Angeles. Her full name is Billie Eilish Pirate Baird O'Connell.

Billie's parents, Maggie Baird and Patrick O'Connell, were longtime actors before joining their teenage daughter's professional team. Raised in a two-bedroom house in Highland Park, where she and her brother were homeschooled, Eilish was encouraged to pursue her interests in dance, gymnastics, horseback riding and especially music. She learned to play the Beatles' "I Will" on the ukulele at age 6; joined Los Angeles Children's Chorus at age 8; and began writing songs by age 11, her talents nurtured through her mother's songwriting class. Eilish has said her first "real" song, "Fingers Crossed," was penned around that time after watching an episode of *The Walking Dead*.
